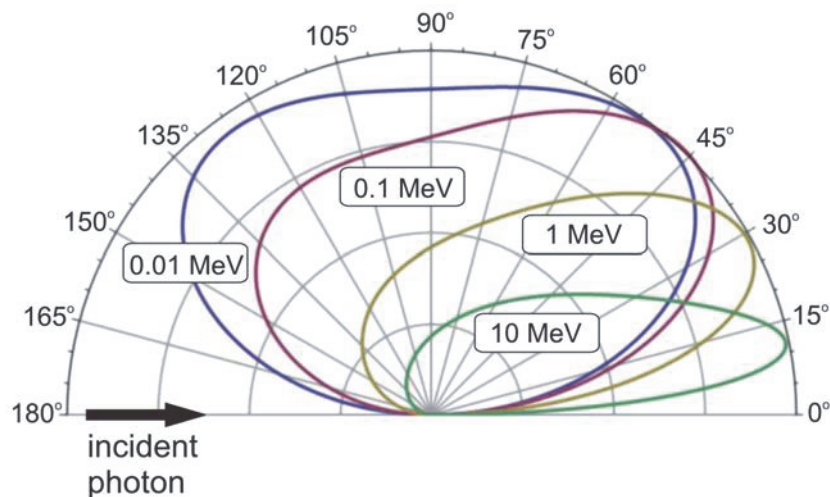


## ERRATA

Page 6-8, Figure 6.5 is incorrect. The conclusion that Compton scattering is increasingly forward directed with increasing energy is correct. The correct figure appears below. The caption remains unchanged.



Page 14-27, example 14.4 currently states, “A 30 degree wedge is used.” It should read, “A 15 degree wedge is used.”

Page 17-7, top of page, should read: “Background radiation levels as measured with a survey meter are typically 0.2  $\mu$ Sv/h...” (The  $\mu$  is missing in front of Sv.)

Page 17-8, first paragraph should read: “...domestic airline flights is 3.3  $\mu$ Sv/h.” (The  $\mu$  is missing in front of Sv.)

Page 17-18, the first and second sentences should read: “...shown to be capable of detecting a minimum of 0.005  $\mu$ Ci...” and “...activity in excess of 0.005  $\mu$ Ci...” (The  $\mu$  is missing in front of Ci in both of these sentences.)
